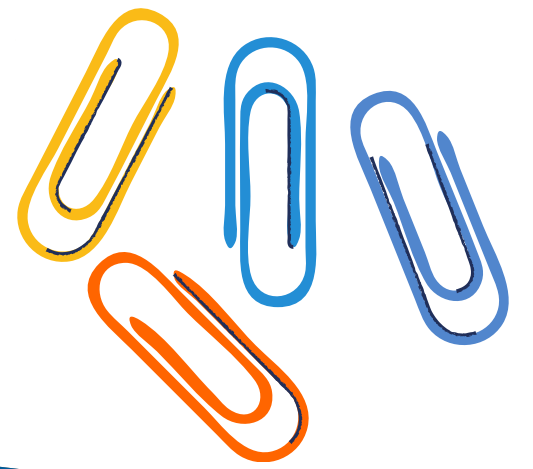

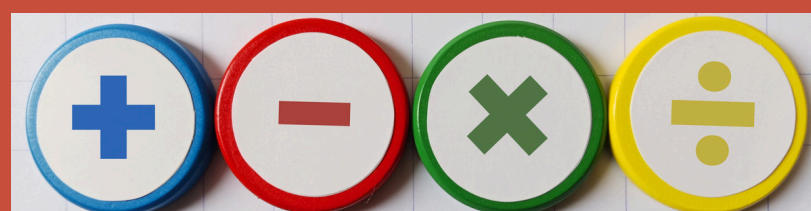
CLUB ACTIVITY

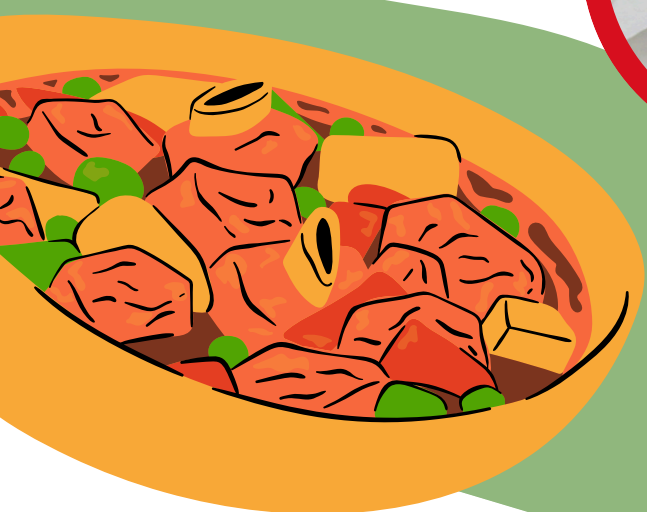
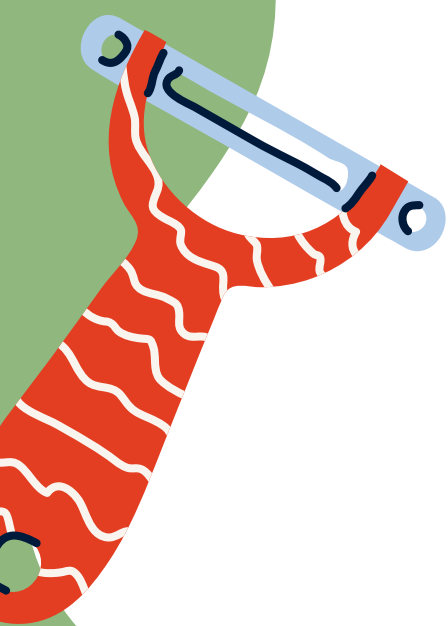
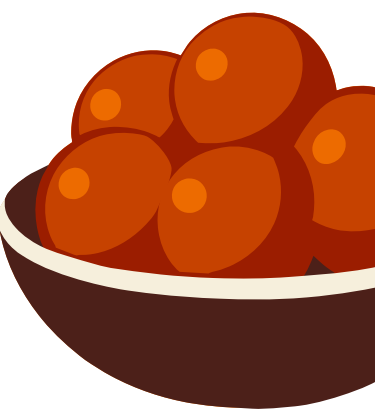
